

For decades I have had to listen to people tell me, "We have NO evidence that anyone ever made lamellar from leather." And in this book there is a surviving example in a museum collection in Turkey of 2nd century LEATHER lamellar. Granted it is horse barding but it is still lamellar made from leather.
