Switching Apple® ID Accounts

1. [Tap] APP STORE
2. [Tap] FEATURED at the bottom of the screen.
3. Scroll to the very bottom of the page.
4. [Tap] APPLE ID (CURRENTLY SIGNED IN ACCOUNT).
5. [Tap] SIGN OUT.
6. Scroll to the very bottom of the page.
7. [Tap] SIGN IN.
8. [Tap] USE EXISTING APPLE ID.
9. Enter the EMAIL and PASSWORD for the Apple ID, and [Tap] OK.

Purchasing Apps

The iOS App Store has over 200,000 apps available to extend the features of your iOS device, many of which are free.

To find and purchase apps:

1. [Tap] APP STORE.
2. Choose FEATURED, CHARTS, CATEGORIES, or one of the other means of browsing the App Store, or enter a SEARCH.
3. [Tap] an app on the page to view a description, ratings, and other information on that app.
4. To purchase that app, [Tap] the price **BUY**.
Note: the price may say FREE.
5. The price will expand to say INSTALL APP (if free) or BUY APP. [Tap] it again.
6. Enter your Apple ID password if prompted, and [Tap] OK.

Note: Apps are made either specifically for the iPad, specifically for the iPhone and iPod touch, or optimized for both. iPad apps will only run on the iPad. iPhone and iPod touch apps will also run on the iPad, but will not fit the entire screen. Apps optimized for both are designated with a **i** next to the price on the App Store page.

Updating Purchased Apps

As app developers release free updates to their apps, those updates will appear for download in the App Store.

1. [Tap] APP STORE.
2. [Tap] UPDATES.
3. [Tap] UPDATE to the right of the app.

Updating the iOS Version

Occasionally, updates to iOS are released, offering new features and bug fixes. The device will display a notification on screen whenever an update is available. Connect your device to a power source, and [Tap] OK. Then [Tap] DOWNLOAD (or GET) (INSTALL). The device will download and install the update, then restart itself.

Deleting an App

1. [Tap] and hold any app until all apps start to wiggle.
2. [Tap] **X** in the corner of the app you wish to delete.
3. [Tap] DELETE. Deleting an app removes the app as well as any user data contained within the app.

Note: The default Apple apps, like Mail or Calendar, cannot be deleted.

Organizing Apps

1. [Tap] and hold any app until all apps start to wiggle.
2. [Drag] the app to wobble.
 - Any app can be [dragged] onto the Dock (the translucent shelf at the bottom of the screen), making it accessible from any Home Screen. The Dock can hold up to six apps on an iPad, or up to four apps on an iPhone or iPod touch.
 - [Drag] the app to the left or right edge of the screen to move to the previous or next Home Screen.
3. Press the Home button to finish.

Making Folders

Apps can be grouped into folders on the Home Screen for better organization.

1. [Tap] and hold any app until all apps start to wiggle.
2. [Drag] an app onto another app you would like to group.
3. [Drag] any additional apps into the folder.
4. [Tap] in the white name field to edit the name of the folder.
5. Press the Home button to finish.

Scroll slowly	Drag
Scroll quickly	Flisk
Undo	Shake device
Zoom In	Pinch apart
Zoom Out	Pinch together
Delete email	Swipe right when viewing list of emails
Go to Home Screen	Home Button
Go to Search Screen	Home Button (while at Home Screen)
Scroll to top of page	Tap the status bar to bring the time at the top of the screen
